TEACH THE CHILDREN DILIGENTLY – SPEAK OF YOUR CHILDREN OFTEN – TRAIN THEM UP IN WAYS THEY SHOULD GO, IN WAYS THEY WILL NOT DEPART FROM

Discipline with hope

DO NOT DISCIPLINE INAPPROPRIATELY - ENCOURAGE REPENTANCE

"Discipline and teach your son while there is hope, and do not [indulge your anger or resentment by imposing inappropriate punishment nor] desire his destruction" Proverbs 19:18 AMP "6 He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers [a reconciliation produced by repentance], so that I will not come and strike the land with a curse [of complete destruction]."

Protect His Children



Do not cause the children to stumble

VINDICATE THE WEAK AND FATHERLESS - DO JUSTICE - MAINTAIN THE RIGHTS OF THE AFFLICTED AND DESTITUTE

"6 but whoever **causes one of these little ones** who believe in Me **to stumble** and sin [by leading him away from My teaching], it would be better for him to have a heavy millstone [as large as one turned by a donkey] hung around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea."

Change your ways to enter the Kingdom of the Heavenly Father

REPENT - BE LIKE CHILDREN – BECOME HUMBLE LIKE A CHILD – BLESS THEM WITH KIND AND ENCOURAGING WORDS

"18 At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, 'Who is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?' ² He called a little child and set him before them, ³ and said, 'I assure you and most solemnly say to you, **unless you repent** [that is, change your inner self—your old way of thinking, live changed lives] and **become like children** [trusting, humble, and forgiving], you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ Therefore, whoever **humbles himself like this child** is greatest in the kingdom of heaven. ⁵ Whoever receives and welcomes one child like this in My name receives Me'"
