



WORSHIP THE HEAVENLY FATHER ONLY – DO NOT TURN TO IDOLS – DO NOT TAKE
THE HEAVENLY FATHER'S NAME IN VAIN – KEEP THE SABBATH – HONOUR AND OBEY
YOUR MOTHER AND FATHER – DO NOT COMMIT MURDER –
DO NOT COMMIT ADULTERY – DO NOT STEAL – DO NOT TESTIFY FALSELY –
DO NOT COVET – BE HOLY

"² I am the Lord your God, who has brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

"3 You shall have **no other gods** before Me.

"4 You shall not make for yourself any idol, or any likeness (form, manifestation) of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth [as an object to worship]. ⁵ You shall not worship them nor serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous (impassioned) God [demanding what is rightfully and uniquely mine], visiting (avenging) the iniquity (sin, guilt) of the fathers on the children [that is, calling the children to account for the sins of their fathers], to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, ⁶ but showing graciousness and steadfast lovingkindness to thousands [of generations] of those who love Me and keep My commandments.

"7 You shall **not take the name of the Lord your God in vain** [that is, irreverently, in false affirmations or in ways that impugn the character of God]; for the Lord will not hold guiltless nor leave unpunished the one who takes His name in vain [disregarding its reverence and its power].

"8 Remember the Sabbath (seventh) day to keep it holy (set apart, dedicated to God). 9 Six days you shall labour and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath [a day of rest dedicated] to the Lord your God; on that day you shall not do any work, you or your son, or your daughter, or your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock or the temporary resident (foreigner) who stays within your [city] gates. 11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and everything that is in them, and He rested (ceased) on the seventh day. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy [that is, set it apart for His purposes].

"12 **Honour** (respect, obey, care for) **your father and your mother**, so that your days may be prolonged in the land the Lord your God gives you.

"13 You shall **not commit murder** (unjustified, deliberate homicide).

"14 You shall **not commit adultery**.

"15 You shall **not steal** [secretly, openly, fraudulently, or through carelessness].

"16 You shall **not testify falsely** [that is, lie, withhold, or manipulate the truth] against your neighbour (any person).

"17 You shall **not covet** [that is, selfishly desire and attempt to acquire] your neighbour's house; you shall not covet your neighbour's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbour."

Be Outspoken For The Mute

JUDGE RIGHTEOUSLY – ADMINISTER JUSTICE FOR THE AFFLICTED AND NEEDY –
DESPISE THE SINS OF YOUR NEIGHBOUR – BE KIND AND MERCIFUL – LEARN TO DO
GOOD - REBUKE THE RUTHLESS – DEFEND THE FATHERLESS – PLEAD FOR THE WIDOW
IN COURT – BE JUST AND HAVE LOVE

Share Food With The Poor

Have A Pure, Unblemished Religion

VISIT AND LOOK AFTER THE FATHERLESS AND WIDOWS – BE STRONG AND EMPOWERED

"27 **Pure and unblemished religion** [as it is expressed in outward acts] in the sight of our God and Father is this: **to visit and look after the fatherless and the widows** in their distress, and to keep oneself uncontaminated by the [secular] world."

Jove Your Enemies

BLESS AND SHOW KINDNESS TO THOSE WHO CURSE YOU – OFFER THE OTHER CHEEK – GIVE WITHOUT DEMANDING IT BACK – TREAT OTHERS THE SAME WAY YOU WANT TO BE TREATED – DO GOOD – LEND EXPECTING NOTHING IN RETURN - BE KIND AND GRACIOUS

"27 But I say to you who hear [Me and pay attention to My words]: **Love** [that is, unselfishly seek the best or higher good for] **your enemies**, [make it a practice to] do good to those who hate you,

²⁸ bless and show kindness to those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. ²⁹ Whoever strikes you on the cheek, offer him the other one also [simply ignore insignificant insults or losses and do not bother to retaliate—maintain your dignity]. Whoever takes away your coat, do not withhold your shirt from him either. ³⁰ Give to everyone who asks of you. Whoever takes away what is yours, do not demand it back. ³¹ Treat others the same way you want them to treat you."

Ask For His Wisdom

³ Blessed [spiritually prosperous, happy, to be admired] are the poor in spirit [those devoid of spiritual arrogance, those who regard themselves as insignificant], for theirs is the kingdom of heaven [both now and forever]. 4 Blessed [forgiven, refreshed by God's grace] are those **who mourn** [over their sins and repent], for they will be comforted [when the burden of sin is lifted]. ⁵ Blessed [inwardly peaceful, spiritually secure, worthy of respect] are **the gentle** [the kind-hearted, the sweet-spirited, the self-controlled], for they will inherit the earth. 6 Blessed [joyful, nourished by God's goodness] are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness [those who actively seek right standing with God], for they will be [completely] satisfied. ⁷ Blessed [content, sheltered by God's promises] are **the merciful**, for they will receive mercy. ⁸ Blessed [anticipating God's presence, spiritually mature] are **the pure in heart** [those with integrity, moral courage, and godly character], for they will see God. 9 Blessed [spiritually calm with life-joy in God's favor] are the makers and maintainers of peace, for they will [express His character and] be called the sons of God. 10 Blessed [comforted by inner peace and God's love] are those who are persecuted for doing that which is morally right, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven [both now and forever]. 11 Blessed [morally courageous and spiritually alive with life-joy in God's goodness] are you when people insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil things against you because of [your association with] Me. 12 Be glad and exceedingly joyful, for your reward in heaven is great [absolutely inexhaustible]; for in this same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you."
